*Kiuna, the only First Nations college in Quebec, is celebrating its 10th anniversary this year. In honour of this milestone, we are sharing a few highlights from the last ten years. Resulting from widespread social and political mobilization among First Nations across Quebec, Kiuna opened its doors on August 22, 2011, to meet the need expressed by First Nations communities for greater access to post-secondary education for their members.

Located in Odanak, Kiuna, meaning “OURS” in Abenaki, is a powerful symbol of the takeover of education by First Nations.

Kiuna is:

- the only college created BY and FOR First Nations, whose diplomas are fully recognized by the Ministry of Education;
- a cutting-edge approach to teaching;
- 115 graduates to date;
- programs based on our knowledge, our traditions, our culture, our history, and our reality;
- French, English, and Indigenous language instruction;
- a learning community created to meet student needs;
- a family-friendly campus;
- a college we can call our own!
