



Data Governance Services and the FNEC Funding Formula

Regional Education Agreement implementation has begun, and the FNEC's data governance staff are getting ready for the annual update that will determine funding levels for the 2023-2024 school year. Our analysts and programmers are working hard to ensure the annual education funding increases issued by the provincial and the federal government are factored into the FNEC funding formula developed BY and FOR First Nations.

The deadline for generating nominal roll reports in CANO has been postponed to October 15. Respecting the school enrollment reporting deadline is crucial for the data governance staff tasked with determining funding allocations for 2023-2024. The FNEC will be helping school administrators with this new process on October 4 and 5, giving our member communities the opportunity to work closely with FNEC staff.

We would like to announce that the FNEC now has two talent acquisition experts. **Samuel McCollough** and **Delphine Rathé** are working hard to give FNEC member communities more visibility than ever through their participation in over a dozen job fairs this fall!
